FIELD COMMENTS BY JIM BUSCH

On November 1, Jim Gingrich and his son, Brian, Tony Ordinec, and I headed west for the opening week of pheasant season in south central Iowa. We saw thousands of pheasants and quail. On opening weekend, Jim's brother-in-law and a friend from Texas joined us. They left on Monday. At the end of the week George Peirce joined us for Friday and Saturday. Generally speaking, the birds won. The crops were still in the fields and the rains had turned those fields into lakes of MUD, nay MNUDD! It was only four inches deep, - four inches if you kept moving. If you got tired and stood still, you kept sinking and sinking and sinking. Six of us got two pheasants opening day. We also got eight quail, but that was only because we got mugged by a covey of 50 quail about half an hour before quitting time. We did better the next day. We got four pheasants. The best two days we had came at the end of the week. The fields dried out a bit and we began refining our techniques. We learned that conversation was OUT. The birds would sit for dogs running by, human walking by, anything except the human voice. One word out of anyone and everything within 100 yards flies. We also learned that we were lousy shots. Anything, I mean anything, except a simple straight away meant a miss. Tony O became our pass shooting EXPERT on the basis of a single kill on a passing right to left. George Peirce became our flock shooting expert on the basis of a single kill on a pheasant flock rise. It was the only one for the week. I became the quail expert on the basis of one double and the most kills on quail. Brian Gingrich got his first solo kill on pheasant on Friday. That bird will be mounted and fly on Brian's wall for eternity. (my first bird still flies - 36 years after mounting - on the Elk horns in the big garage) We had a ball!

Just a side light! Six guys got fined \$10,000 for having 89 pheasants in possession. Legally they could have had 54 pheasants in possession. It was incredibly stupid to have 89 pheasants. Fifty-four was a lot of shooting. Why stretch? But what great shots those six guys must be!

During the course of our Idye many scenarios unfolded. Among them was the answer to the question of what constitutes a safe shot. Names will be omitted here but the lessons will not. Situation: A covey of quail exploded from the creek bottom and scattered up hill into the adjoining corn field. We scattered up the hillside after the covey. A single flew and was dropped further up the hill. The shooter went after it. More quail flew - another shot after another single. The original shooter was directly under the second quail as the shot went off. Comment from second shooter, "I didn't know you were there!" Situation: Quail jumps in front of hunter on left, flies by hunter in center, is shot directly in front of hunter on right. Hunter on right says, "I'll pick it up for you." Heavy Sarcasm. Situation: Two hunters working in the draw near end with two others blocking point. Bird in the air. Shot. One driver shoots, one driver ducks throwing arm to cover face. The blocker hears BB's hit fence post nearby. Situation: Bird rises and flies ahead hunter "A" who fires and misses. Hunter "B" who is slightly behind and to the rear reach, drops the bird. "A" cringes as the blast of BB's shot hits his ears.

What are the common parts in each of these scenarios? No one was hit. But, in each instance, someone felt threatened. That and that alone makes those "bad shots." When you're hunting with a buddy, not shooting him is insufficient. Never never should your partner OR anyone else for that matter, feel threatened by your actions. The mere perception of danger by your hunting buddy makes you a dangerous hunting partner.

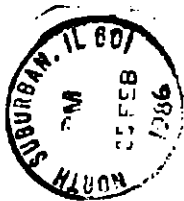
