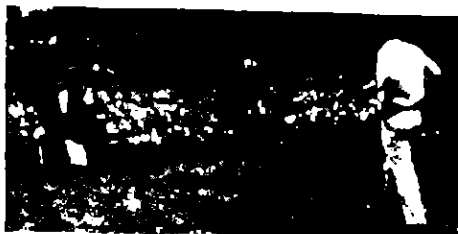

FALL 1976 FIELD TRIAL

Mark your calendar -- Save the weekend of Sept. 11-12 for The VCOI Fall Field Trial at The Desplaines Wildlife Area near Joliet. There should be something for everyone. The Amateur Gun Dog and The Open Derby are going to be for VIZSLAS ONLY, and the Open Puppy, Open Gun Dog and The Open Limited Gun Dog are going to be for all continental Pointing Breeds. There will be two courses running on Saturday, and one on Sunday. Although we will be in conflict with several other local trials, we should fill up fast, so be SURE TO SEND YOUR ENTRIES IN BY RETURN MAIL OR YOU MAY NOT GET INTO YOUR OWN CLUB TRIAL!!!

On one course, Lynn Hadlock and Tony Baron will be judging the Open Derby and Open Limited Gun Dog. Both of these stakes will be finished by Saturday night. The Derby is for Vizslas only and will be a 12 minute back course and an eight min. bird field. The field trial committee felt that, because of the probable heat and greenness, that we will encounter at this early date, a bird field and a short back course would be in the best interests on the young dogs. The Ltd. Gun Dog, however, will be a severe test of both dog and handler. The first series will be 1/2 hour with no bird field and no birds released. There will be native birds and the birds that have escaped from the Derby Bird Field for the dogs to find. When all dogs have run, the judges will select dogs for a second series, which will be composed of a short back course and a full eight minute Bird field with gunning being done by the handler. Dogs for the second series will be selected by the judges from the dogs with the best back courses who are birdless or clean with bird contact. In other words, finding birds in the first series is no guarantee of being called back nor is going birdless going to keep you out of the second series. Needless to say, any dog who goes through both series without finding game will be called birdless and not be placed.

On the other course, judges Lee Martin and Jerry Craig will begin with the Amateur Gun Dog which will be a 22 min. back course and eight min. birdfield. Blanks will be fired in the birdfield on game contact. Dogs to be placed will be called back for a kill and retrieve with gunning being done by the handler. The Puppy, which will follow the Amateur Gun Dog will consist of a 15 min. course with no bird field and no birds released. There should be plenty of birds around for the puppies to find, since no birds will be killed in the Amateur Gun Dog. The Puppy stake may run over into Sunday, depending on the number of entries in the AGD and the Puppy. The Open Gun Dog will follow the Puppy Stake, but will not begin before Sunday A.M. This stake will consist of a 22 min. back course and an eight min. bird field with gunning being done by official guns. We hope to have about 105 entries in the trial with a higher percentage of Vizslas.

Breakfast and lunch will be served on the grounds by the ladies of the VCOI on both days. There will be no banquet but the Club will entertain the judges and their wives at the Colonial Inn Dining Room on Sat. evening. This is the motel where the judges and most trialers will be staying for the weekend.

Dorothy Rosenberg will be in charge of food and would appreciate offers of HELP. We have four stakes with bird fields and can use all the help we can get planting birds. (Contact Jim Busch) Remember, SEND YOUR ENTRY IN AS SOON AS YOU RECEIVE IT. THIS IS IMPORTANT!!




