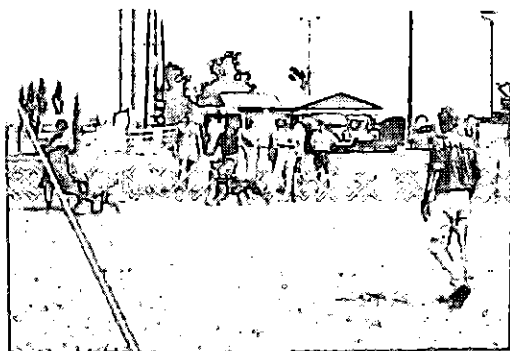

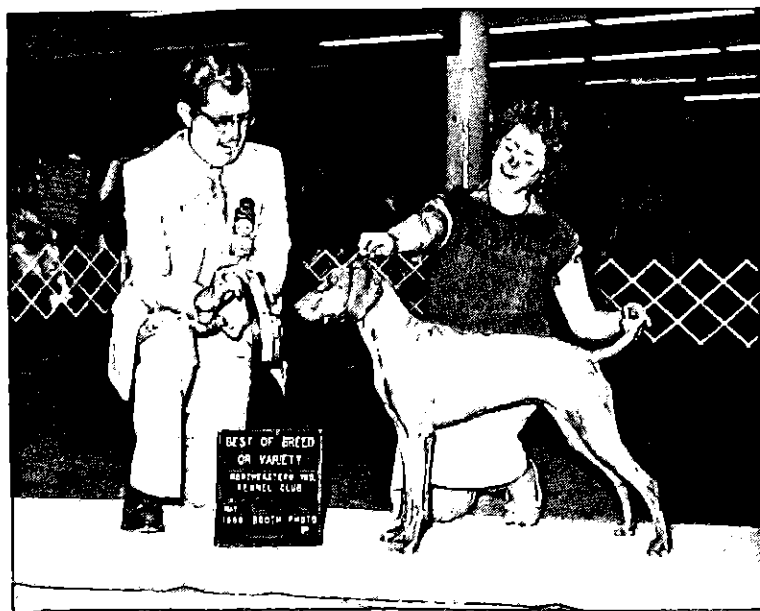

THE VCOI DOUBLE BUBBLE WEEKEND
July 19-20

The Specialty was on Saturday, the Fun Trial was on Sunday. Weatherwise it was an almost flawless weekend. Saturday was hot, probably too hot for the dogs to be at their best, but the 39 entries at the Specialty held up and looked great. Ch. Solo, owned and handled by David Lee of Minnesota repeated last year's Best of Breed win and then went on to take a second in Group. Keystone's Redfield Comet, owned by Jean Engle and Deb Fridlund, came from the Open Bitch class to take it - Winner's Bitch (finishing her conformation championship), Best of Winners, and topping a snazzy group of bitch specials as Best of Opposite Sex. This feat is the surprise that I foretold in last month's VIZSLA FIELD. A male named Ishmetelja, owned and handled by Nick Besnick captured Winner's Dog to take the points there. I believe that this win was three majors in a row (out of four shows entered) for this owner-handled Vizsla.

After the Breed judging, we all lunched and hung around the show grounds. Many thanks to the ladies of the Illinois Vizsla club who provided the lunch. As usual, it was the best. Group was scheduled for about 1:30p.m. Twenty or more of us surrounded the ring and hooted, hollared and clapped as Solo strutted his stuff. Solo appeared to hear and respond to the crowd noise as he toured the ring. Beaten only by the top winning Sporting Dog in the country, a 2nd in Group was his reward. He looked great - a fitting Vizsla champion!

Fortunately, Sunday a.m. was 20 degrees cooler than it had been all week. The sun was out, but the temp was down and the dogs looked tremendous at the fun trial. We ran 79 entries in the field events and 18 other entries in the non-field events. A small entry fee was charged in the five major field events and everything else was free. We used about 112 quail and enough homing pigeons to put three birds in the field for each brace that ran.

We took a one hour lunch break and everyone was able to sit down at the same time to break bread and enjoy good fellowship. Eighty-seven year old Grandpa Busch treated everyone to his famous Hunter's Stew. There was enough this year so that seconds and/or thirds were available for everyone who wanted it. (and there's still some left in the refrigerator !!!) We have begun the practice of a definite lunch time at our fun and field trials. There is something about sitting down together for a meal that draws the group together better than anything else.

Our fun trial judges were Bill Elliott, George Peirce, Tony Ordonez - all from Illinois, AND Jim Gingrich, now from Seattle, WA. Jim got to ride his Tennessee Walker for the second time. Jim picked up his horse from Tom Gaulke in November '85, got a promotion and transfer to Seattle in Dec. '85 and had to report to work out there on Jan. 3, 1986. Jim was in Rockford for a business meeting so he was placed in the judicial saddle for most of the day. We are anxiously waiting to hear how the horse-sore spots on his body responded to the business meetings every day this week.

Nick Hauser from Waco, Texas, was our other guest judge. Nick was also in town on business. He called Ken Crago to ask if there were any shows around that he might attend for the weekend, and Ken brought him out to the Specialty. Nick had such a good time that he returned Sunday for the fun trial even though Ken could not. We tapped him to judge the 22 dog field trial hunter stake. Nick was wearing shorts, tee shirt, and hunting boots. The costume was a bit unorthodox, but considering the weather and his out-of-town status, O.R.! His legs were starting to "pink up" prior to beginning his judging assignment. There were 11 braces and at 10 min./brace, that is about 2 hours of judging. At the end, his legs were approaching brick red. We are left wondering how the trousers of Monday's business day felt rubbing on the sunburned expanse of leg from mid-thigh to lower calf. Ouch!!! The club bought Nick a Harmer produced VCOI cap. Nick generously donated the cost of the cap back to the club treasury. In retrospect, we probably should have provided the cap before his two-hour afield afoot began. Thanks to all the fine gentlemen who judged for us.

Five Vizslas qualified for their Certified Hunting Dog award. Many more fulfilled the necessary requirements up to the mandatory retrieve. I have always been told that Vizslas are great natural retrievers. I believed it too. At the last several fun trials, the retrieve has been the stumbling block for many in their attempt to earn that coveted parchment Certified Hunting Dog award certificate.

Butch Misty's Spirit was declared Dog of the Day by the panel of judges. He was the winner of the non-field trial hunter stake and also placed fourth in the broke dog event. Bill Lyman has worked hard and has developed him into a fine example of what a Vizsla bird dog should be.

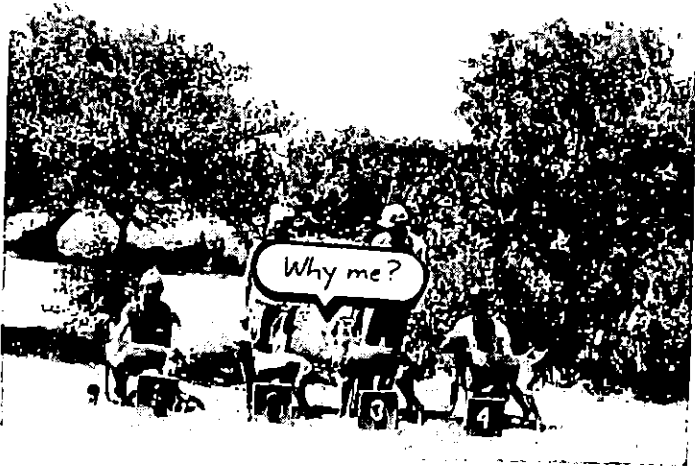

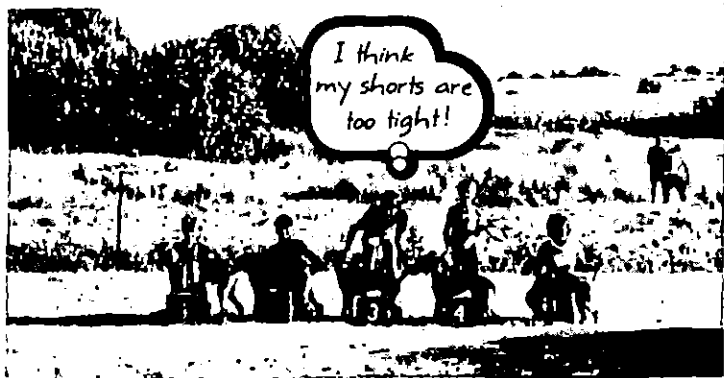

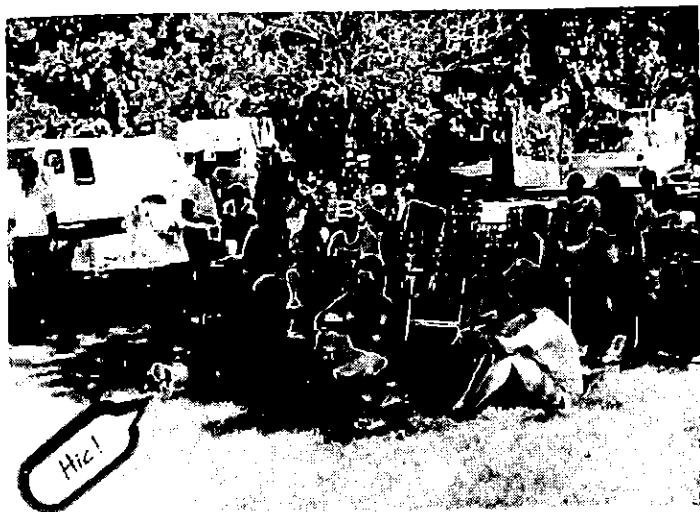
