October is fast approaching, and the National events will be upon us before we know it. But, WHAT THE HECK ARE "THE NATIONALS", ANYWAY?

Sponsored and paid for by the Vizsla Club of America, the Nationals are the parent club's yearly field, show and obedience events. They are hosted by a regional club on a rotating basis, either in the East, West, or Midwest.

THE SHOW EVENTS are made up of Regular Classes, Non-regular Classes, Best of Breed, Parade of Champions, Puppy Sweepstake, and Obedience.

The Regular classes are the same as the Regular Classes offered at AKC dog shows. Non-regular Classes include Veteran Dogs & Veteran Bitches (over 7 years of age), and Field Trial Dogs & Field Trial Bitches (dogs/bitches that have placed in an AKC licensed Field Trial), Stud Dog Class, Brood Bitch Class, and Brace Class.

The Parade of Champions is for Vizslas with a Show Championship, Field Championship, or Obedience Title. The Puppy Sweepstake is open to puppies at least 6 months old and not more than 18 months old on the day of the show. A percentage of the Sweepstake entry fee is paid out in prize money. The Obedience Classes are those offered at AKC dog shows.

In the next Bulletin, the entry requirements and performance standards for the Field Events will be outlined. If you are not a member of the Vizsla Club of America, but would like to join, a membership application is enclosed.
