1986 VCOI DOUBLE BUBBLE

The Vizsla Club of Illinois will be celebrating its second consecutive Specialty Show and Fun Trial Combination on the weekend of July 19th & 20th. Last year our participants came from all points of the compass. It was the largest gathering of Vizslaphiles between Nationals. They came from as far away as the Twin Cities, Mn.; Kansas City, Mo.; Louisville, Ky.; and Ingomar, Pa. You know what happens when Vizslaphiles come that far to compete? They have a ball! AND they talk! They talk about Vizslas in the field, in the show, in obedience, in the breeding room and whelping box, AND they talk about people, especially the people who are not there.

Either the Specialty or the Fun Trial should be enough incentive for everyone to attend. Put them together and it becomes a bargain package that is too good a deal to pass up. Gas prices are low, even so it does cost bucks to travel to anywhere. Anytime you can catch two fantastic Vizsla activities with one gas expenditure, you have made the second activity not only free, but also a money maker.

The Saturday (July 19) Specialty is held at the Kishwaukee Valley Kennel Club show, which is at the Boone County Fairgrounds, only 10 minutes from our (Jim and Linda Busch) house. The Fun Trial on Sunday, (July 20) will be held on our five acres + (plus some friendly neighbor's ground). The inside beds are all spoken for already. There is plenty of bedroll room on the carpet however. There is also plenty of room for campers and trailers in our yard. It's not necessary to drop us a note to tell us you're coming and approx when, but if you did, it would help planning.

At the Specialty, Kjellstrom is judging Vizslas and K. Mueller is judging the sporting group. The entry is always very large and we always show about 10 a.m. (Busch's prediction - something unusual will happen during the judging - a class dog or juvenile will win big) The VCOI has a hospitality area roped off under the only tree at the show site and everyone gathers after the showing to de-brief, and break bread with all the food and drinks provided by the VCOI. Italian Beef, delicious bean salads, macaroni salads, veggies, fruits, and fantastic deserts are on the menu. Beverages include lemonade, soft drinks, and beer. It's worth coming just for the chow.

After the get together at the show, we knockdown and adjourn to the Busch place for more beverages and talk, practice for the fun trial, and talk. At Group judging time the place empties out and we all head back to the fairgrounds to cheer the Vizsla B.O.B. through the Group.

We don't know if we have any influence, but last year our entry won the Group and a Westie that we cheered for placed 4th in it's group. ~~It was the only off-breed that wanted to hire our clique... (just~~ joking)

Then it's back to Busches for more party time, practice and talk.

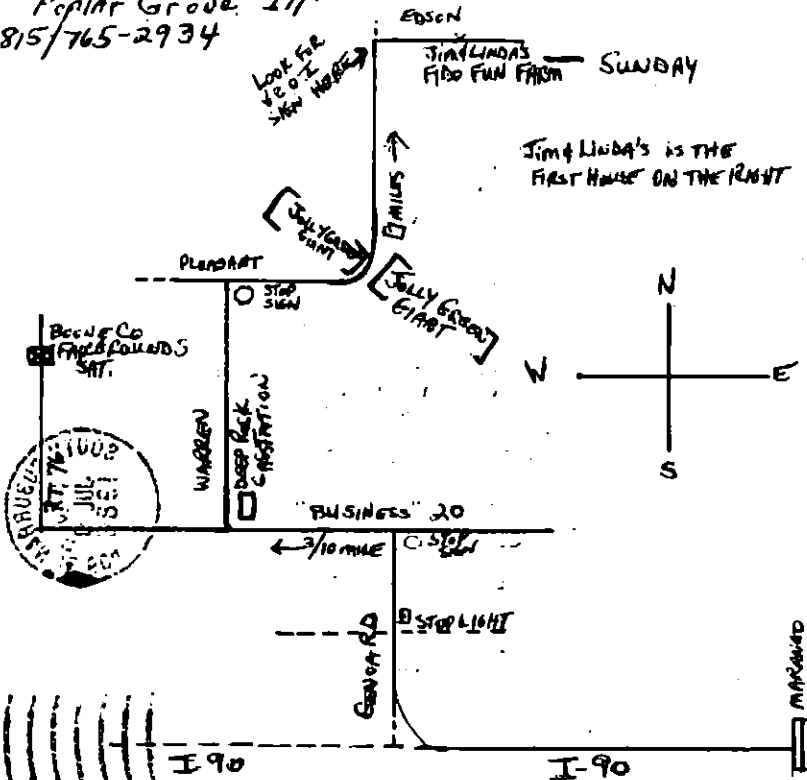
On Sunday, coffee and rolls are provided for breakfast. Lunch is a bring your own plus a little to share - or a lot if you have a special item you're proud of. The VCOI will have a 1/2 barrel on ice and soft drinks. There will be a refrigerator in the garage for storage. Bill Elliott has donated his 18 cu ft beauty to make the party even greater. For last year's participants, Grandpa Busch has already begun planning on a giant pot of Hunter's Stew - bring your own bowl and spoon.

The competition will begin at 8:30 a.m. with the Field Trial Young Dog event. After that the order of events has not been established yet. The events will include: F.T. Hunter, Broke dog, Non-F.T. Young Dog, Non-F.T. Older Dog, Powder Puff (ladies only), Jr. Handler (15 & under), Trick Contest, Wing & String Championship, 2 Pigeon Races, Bird Planting Contest (15 & under).

We had 100+ entries in February and 80+ last year in July. Obviously many of the events must run concurrently with others, but the conflicts are minimal and no one is denied the opportunity to enter. Each field event will cost \$7.00 per entry except for Jr. Handler which is free.

That's about it. A lot of preparation goes into this weekend and as a result we can guarantee that you will enjoy yourself. Remember, July 19 and 20, the place to be for all Vizslaphiles is Boone County, Illinois at the VIZSLA CLUB OF ILLINOIS SPECIALTY AND FUN TRIAL. 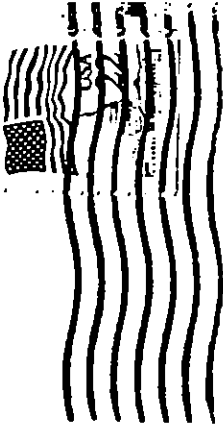
