OTHER D.O.G. SERVICES

PUPPY CLASSES

D.O.G. has initiated a 5-week puppy class for dogs 2.5 months old. Classes meet once a week for 1 hour. Work includes socializing the puppies, house-breaking, problem avoidance and obedience work. Fee: \$40 per dog. Scheduled classes on Tuesday evenings, 7 to 8 PM — first class only is 7 to 9 PM **WITHOUT** dogs. Classes start every 5 weeks — call for dates.

D.O.G. instructors also convene private clinics for puppies on an appointment basis; call for further information.

PROBLEM CLINICS

For people who can't wait for a class to start or when a problem is so pressing it requires immediate attention, D.O.G. instructors will make appointments with individual owners to begin problem solving work immediately.

D.O.G. HOTLINE

D.O.G. maintains a 24-hour answering service for students and returns most calls within 24 hours. Also, handlers who have completed a D.O.G. novice obedience course can return to any D.O.G. novice course with the same dog or use the problem hotline at any time without further charge. Handlers may also take a refresher novice course with the same dog at no charge.

D.O.G. ADVANCED TRAINING

D.O.G. convenes an annual 12-week course in Open Obedience. Limited to dogs and handlers who have successfully completed Novice Obedience work, this course includes retrieving, down on recall, polished off-leash heeling, broad jumping, and retrieving over a high jump. Call for class location and starting time.

OTHER SITES AND CLASSES

D.O.G. convenes classes in many other locations in the Chicago metropolitan area and is constantly investigating new training sites as well. To find out about other classes and sites, call our Elmhurst office at 530.0797.

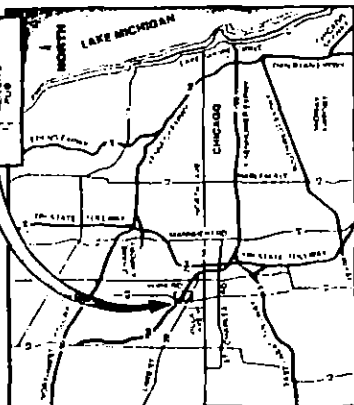
