Courses and Birds

- All stakes single course without a bird field.
- Wild and/or released quail and/or chukar, and/or pheasant used in ALL stakes.
- A blank pistol will not be fired in puppy stakes.
- Horseback handling will NOT be permitted in any stakes.
- The use of AKC Approved Tracking Collars will be permitted in all stakes and will follow AKC regulations pertaining to the use of tracking collars.

Parking/Camping

Camping is allowed on the grounds, but there are NO SERVICES and units must be self-contained. An overnight fee of \$8 a night is charged and payable to the IDNR. Pit toilets are on the grounds.

Wrangler

Handler horses/wrangler will not be provided.

Horse Owners

Those with Horses are asked by the DNR to use the new gravel parking area first, and are encouraged to use the pasture area for staking-out their horses.

If you use a stall(s) in the barn, you are required to clean it prior to your departure. Everyone with horses is required to clean-up after them and place manure on the designated concrete pads located in each of the parking lots.

Those on gravel areas, need to place manure on the concrete pads and scatter hay/straw refuse in the grass adjacent to them.

ANYONE with horses on the paved parking area must remove ALL hay, straw and manure from the pavement, prior to departure each day as required by the DNR and our agreement with them.

Water will be available onsite along with tubs.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR HORSES AND DOGS.
