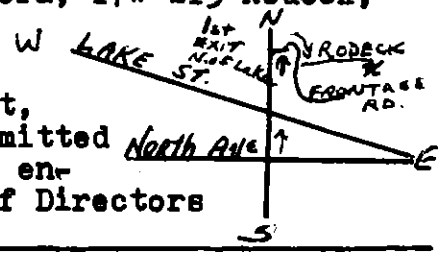

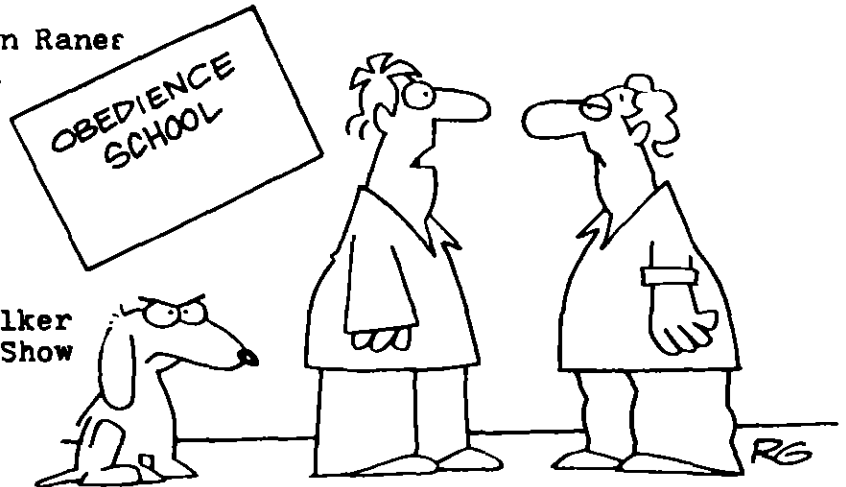

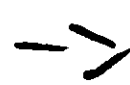

As you can see by the list of placements, the VCOI fun trial held on August 7th at Busch's place (plus PIK acres) went on for a very long time. If only the placed dogs had been present it would have been a large event. In fact, seventy dogs toed the line for participation in one event or another. We even found time for a lengthy talk by vet, Joe Frost, on how to improve your relationship with your vet, thereby maximizing the benefits you will receive.

It was a great day for getting a tan, but way too hot for running dogs. We had four places to water them along the route and used them all on virtually every brace. That is quite a feat with a five minute back course and five minute bird field.

The main judge was Jay (Fred) Austin. Fred was an active member of the Vizsla Club of America in the '60's and early '70's. He was a VCOI officer. He competed in shows and in field trials and was the breeder of Dual & Amateur Field Champion Jodi's Jump-N-Bing-Bang Bucz. While Fred was the anchor, others who judged during the day were Bob Schroader, Geno Woehrle, Bill Elliott, Gordy Crull, Tony Lucas, Doug Traven, George Peirce, and Roy Greffin.

The Dog of the Day Award is presented to the winner of one of the major events at the fun trial that comes closest to the ideal for the event in which it is entered. The D.O.D. receives the traveling trophy and keeps it until the next fun trial. The trophy has a plate that has the names of all previous winners on it. That list reads like a Who's Who of Midwest Vizslas. At this trial, the winner was Amber Star of Henna who belongs to Tony and Gina Ordonez. I know how much work Tony has poured into getting Amber ready for this fun trial because he has been making the trip out to Poplar Grove at least once a week to train. Amber is just a few days shy of two years old. Unfortunately, she will be too old to enter the Derby at the Illinois trial. While Tony and Gina were estatic to win Powder Puff, Non-Field Trial Young Dog, the Pigeon Race, Dog of the Day award, and a Certified Hunting Dog Award they were broken hearted that Amber's mother, Gina's Henna, could not be entered because of being in heat. If she had run, she would have been a real threat in the Hunter event.

Another problem in that area is the "professional amateur handler", i.e. the man who is not a pro but is very good at handling, perhaps trains with the pro and then handles the pro's string in the amateur events. That's a tough one! The amateur wants the pro's entries to help pay for the trial, but he doesn't want him to win. Once again, the appearance of things is all important. If the pro went out of his way to get a variety of handlers for his string in the amateur events and included the owners of the dogs whenever possible, most of the complaints would evaporate. Once again, the pro must see that a problem exists and work to alleviate it. Changing the rules to address the problem takes too long and the new rules would be too easily circumvented.

Trudy will be sent a F H U patch just as soon as they return from the patch maker. She got a placement at the Mayflower GSP trial in the amateur gun dog with Trefa. Unofficial President Sharon Schroader will be thrilled to have another woman in F H U.

Next week is Brook's Willie Whompum's retirement party being held in conjunction with a VCOI meeting at Tom Harmer's house. Willie has done well over the last ten years. If you will look at the amateur top ten accompanying this article, Willie occupies the #4 spot. The #1 spot is FC/AFC Willie's Bushwak Barney McGee (son of Willie). Barney is a National Derby winner, amateur trained and handled in the midwest. The #5 dog is Chambers Voros Tars Duke (son of Willie), also #7 on the Open list, pro-trained and handled in the southwest. The #8 dog is AFC Willie's Cedar Chip, amateur trained and handled on the east coast. The #9 dog is Ch. Caesar's Image Barging Buck, amateur trained and handled in the midwest (Buck was BOB at VCOI Specialty in '82 - about 50 entries) Also FC/AFC Willie's Russett Duke with 94 points and Willie's Cactus Flower with 93 points just miss an amateur top ten listing this month. Both children of Willie and both amateur trained and handled. Those six dogs came out of five different bitches. My current records cover the period from July 1, 1982 to the present. There are approximately 74 Vizslas that have earned gun dog placements during this time. Approximately 16% of them are Willie and his get. There are currently approximately 40 dogs on the puppy/derby honor roll. Approximately 20% of them are closely related to Brook's Willie Whompum. What a record with which to retire. He's got it all - looks - ability - prepotency! May you have a long - healthy - happy - retirement.

Jim Busch said it. Another year has come to an end, the field trial year that spans July 1, 1982, to June 30, 1983. I have always maintained that this year makes more sense than the calendar year because the summer break is better defined than the first of the year break. Just to please everyone, we do it both ways.

At the top of the Amateur list is FC & AFC Willie's Bushwak Barney McGee, owned and handled by Doug Traven (Dr. Doug) of Illinois. Doug got Barney as an already finished dog from Mike Florian (Barney's original owner and developer). It took about a year for rapport to develop and then Barney began winning. During that year, Doug quickly learned the skills necessary to handle a gun dog successfully. It's fun to win but it's more fun to win if you have developed the dog yourself. So...Doug got a pup out of Ch. Caesar's Image Barging Buck and Ch. Woehrle's Windjammer Jody. That pup is Troopers Staunch Standish (Stanley). Stan didn't get puppy points. He was close a bunch of times but Doug was still learning. He knew he had a good one and worked hard to develop him. Stanley became a top winning young Vizsla and captured his derby points at Michigan the week before the Nationals beating many of the same dogs that were entered in the National Derby Stake. Stan has a March birthdate. That made him just under 2½ at the VCOI fun trial on August 7th. It was Stan's first outing as a Gun Dog and he scored, placing second in a field of seven Vizslas. Dr. Doug and Barney and Stanley will be tough to beat for a long time to come.

With all of the above light-heartedly in mind, the check for \$12.00 for a one year subscription to the VIZSLA FIELD is in the mail today.

Sadly, because of the personal nature of the entry, and because some might not understand, it will not be printed as a subtitle. We will use a combination of parts of entries of two other prize winners. Bob Schroader wins an Askim "Paw Print" autograph for his entry, "An Enumeration of Excellence Versus An Aggregation of Accumulation.....Or.....Quality Will Out!!" We found this verbage to be very appealing, but because of the obstruse combination of esoterica, concluded that it also should not be used. Hank Rozanek, our other "Paw Print" autograph winner sent in five entries. His quantitative approach alone earned him a runner-up prize. Combining Schroader and Rozanek, ethereal and earthy, we come up with the sub-title that will forever (or at least until we change it) grace the top of the top ten, sic. "A National Enumeration of True Excellence". It has a certain heavenly ring to it. don't you think?

I got a great letter from Trudy Lanman. Trudy and I share a deep deep concern that the sport of Vizsla field trialing runs a real risk of losing the amateur "supporter-competitor-participant". The professional trainers, Chauncey, Del, Denes, Hank, and Bill must be convinced that "stomping on the amateur" is not in their best interest even though it does produce more ribbons. The pro, because he is a professional, has even a deeper obligation to the sport. Not only must he not "stomp on the amateur", but also he must avoid any appearance of doing that. He must even go one step farther and bend over backwards to help his amateur bracemente. Over the years I have been braced with all of those pros on more than one occasion. It is difficult not to name names, but suffice it to say, two of those five are the best bracementes an amateur could possibly draw. Likewise, two of them are the worst bracementes an amateur could draw. The fifth man is sometimes a good bracemente and sometimes a bad one, depending upon which dog he runs. I leave it to you to put the names to the descriptions.

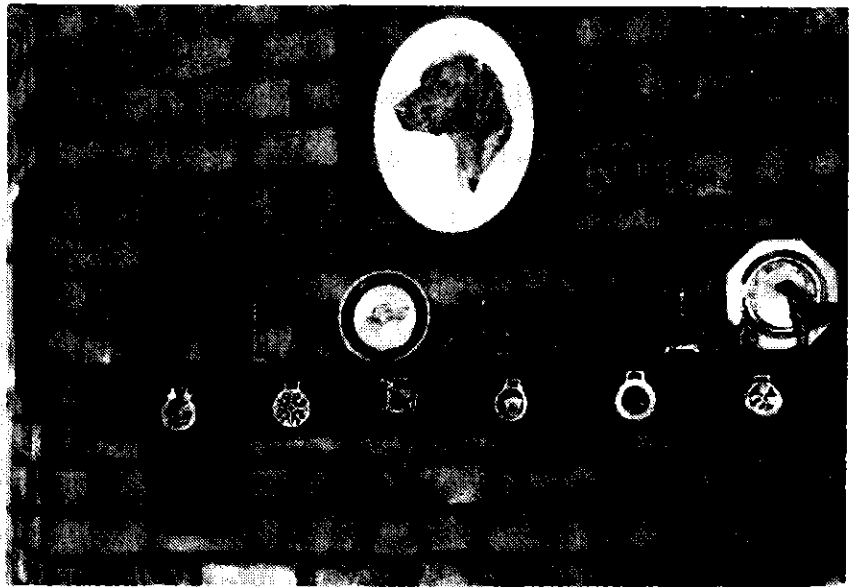

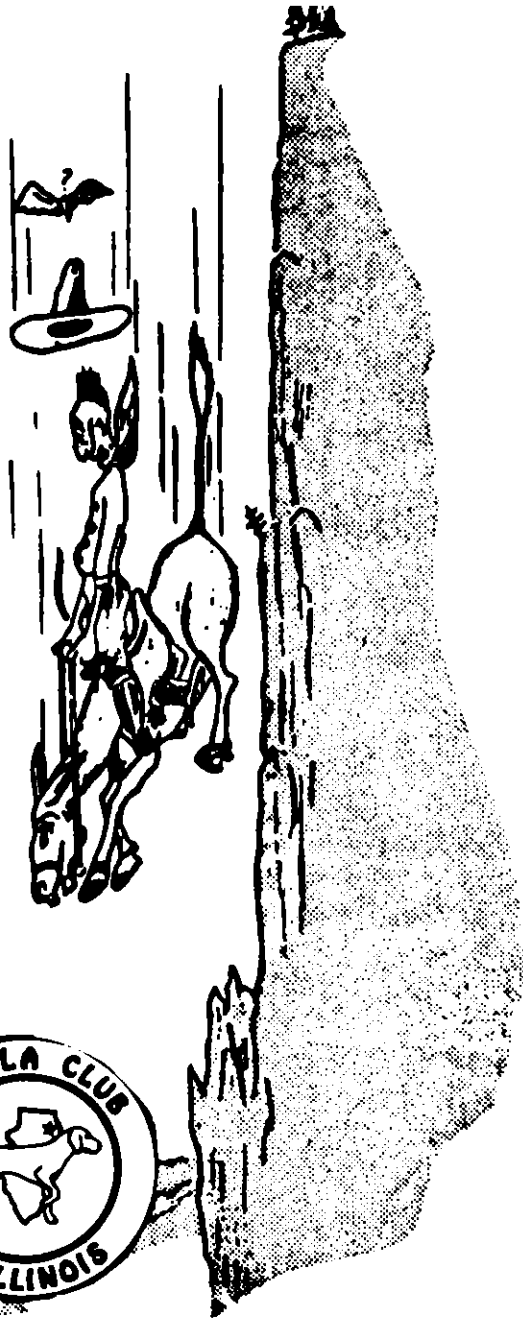
