Saturday dawned on a beautiful day, with a slight moderation in the prevailing temperature! Judge Arlene Thompson and 44 Vizslas were on hand. A healthy entry in the Open Classes resulted in 5-point majors for both dogs and bitches. Taking the Winner's Dog award was Thistledown Theron Bayard, owned by Jack & Renee Izard, with the Reserve Winner's Dog going to Dallerry's Hunter, owner-handled by Karen Perry (co-owner is David Perry).

Winning a large bitch class and finishing her championship at the tender age of 11 1/2 months was Morning Sky Rude & Reckless, who made the trip east from Omaha, Nebraska, with her owners Andy & Lorre Schmidt. Reserve Winner's Bitch went to Keystone's Ishah, JH (a.k.a. Liz), handled by owner Debby Fridlund.

The Best of Breed entry presented a great looking lineup of Vizslas for Judge Thompson's consideration. After
a careful evaluation of each dog, her choice for Best
of Breed was Ch. Polar Kap's Four on the Floor, who was
skillfully shown by his owner Kathy Harmer. "Shifter"
was also a star in last year's Specialty Show when he
took the Winner's Dog award. Ch. Four Winds Scarlett
O'Hagen, JH, owned by Tom & Debbie Hagen, was selected
as Best of Opposite Sex, coming from the Field Bitch class.
With a Junior Hunter title to her credit, Scarlett has
proven she's more than just another pretty face! Judge
Thompson's final decision was to name Morning Sky Rude







To standardize information submitted, I have come up with a short form which should help get all the pertinent details. If your dog earns a title, send a picture and I'll try to work it in to the newsletter!


