From The Mailbag comes a letter from Chris Welker (formerly Honeycutt). She wrote to share an unhappy experience she had with her bitch Sri's recent litter of puppies, and to pass on the information to others. After moving back from Central Illinois, Chris needed bedding for the puppies and purchased a bag of COMPRESSED PINE. It was untreated and looked very similar to the bedding used in hamster or gerbil cages. Chris used the bedding only ONCE, and within 3-4 hours five of the nine-week ald pupples were dead. An autopsy showed the puppies both ate and inhaled : the bedding, resulting in their deaths. Chris went on to say the best bedding to use is shredded newspapers or On a happier note, the four surviving puppies are doing fine. Chris kept a male, Eros, and the other three are happy in their new homes. One puppy, Orion had a long way to go - he was air-shipped to Liz Walker in Anchorage, Alaska!! I would like to thank Chris for sharing this with us.

Don't forget your dog's heartworm preventative! Our vet said he has already seen several cases of heartworm in dogs which were probably infected last fall. BE SURE to have your dog checked first!
